Ephesians 4:1-16

*Bethel's Mission is described simply as **Love God – Love Others – Serve the World**. These phrases are the basis for our Vision and Values. As you consider the passage this week, look at it through the lens of our Mission/Vision/Values and allow it to clarify what you believe and guide how you live.*

A church on point moves forward together, by faith. Think about the different ways that Paul emphasizes unity in this passage and how that helps you understand the local church better.

The analogy of the body is often used by Paul to illustrate the church. In what ways is this analogy of growth and working together helpful to you in thinking about the church?

What does the analogy of the body teach you about the vision and strategy of how the church functions?

Jesus Christ is central in the passage. Examine the different places in the passage where Christ is mentioned and consider what that teaches you about Jesus and your relationship to him in the life of the church.
