This passage begins the most important week in history. Think about it today and in the coming four weeks, as we approach Easter.

1. CONTEXT: John lays out all the important details of this passage in the first two verses, and in the preceding chapter. Why are these details of place, time and people important?

2. OBSERVATION: Smell is not often important to a passage, but it is here – why? What do you observe about Judas from his first recorded words?

3. MEANING: Mary seems to be the only person aware of what is going to happen to Jesus less than a week after this event. How was it that Mary alone understood that Jesus was about to die?

4. APPLICATION: Read Luke 10:38-42. Are you more like Mary, or more like Judas? How can you more often sit at the feet of Jesus and learn from him?
