# At Home Study Guide

For the week of April 7, 2019

*Lavish (verb): to bestow something in generous or extravagant quantities. Has someone ever lavished something upon you? God did, in the riches of his grace (Ephesians 1:7-8). He desires that we reflect his generosity in our lives. We will focus on the generous life in this four-week series leading into Easter.*

1. *CONTEXT: Two key words in this passage (Matt. 6:19-33) seem to be treasure and anxiousness. Why would these be important words when we think about generosity?*

2. *OBSERVATION: What analogies does Jesus use when he speaks of treasures and anxiousness? Why does he use these various analogies?*

3. *MEANING: When treasures of this world become our idols, anxiety quickly pursues through fear or loss. What counsel does Jesus provide in these verses?*

4. *APPLICATION: How does this passage challenge you? As God brings it to light, in what areas do you see that you need to change?*
