The Bible gives simple instructions on how to live. Ephesians 5:1-2 keeps it simple, instructing us to be imitators of God and walk in love. How do we practically live that out? Follow along as we consider a new truth each week to help us live as God's dearly loved children.

1. Each of us has needs, like the leper. Do you cry out to God for your need, or try to fix it yourself? What do you need to bring to God?

2. Jesus sent the ten to the priest because that's what a cured leper would do – go to the priest. The priest judged whether people were cured. In what ways do you have trouble obeying Jesus by faith?

3. Thankful people proclaim it, just like the one leper. What can you thank God for? What can you tell others that you are thankful for?
