1. Read Exodus 34:6. In this passage God is declaring his name to Moses. Why do you think it is important that the first two words God uses to describe himself are "merciful and gracious"?

2. *"Good sense makes one slow to anger, and it is his glory to overlook an offense."* (Proverbs 19:11 ESV) When has someone overlooked an offense you committed? Why is that action wise and gracious?

3. When is it hardest for you to be grace-filled? In what ways can you allow Jesus to help you be filled with grace and truth (see John 1:14)?
