For the week of July 12, 2020

God is light. God is love. Both are simple statements with profound implications. John digs into these truths in the letter called 1 John. Pray and think over this 9 week series about how God's light and God's love affect how to relate to God, others, and the world.

1. The opening four verses are very different than other New Testament letters. What do you notice? Why do you think John refers to the beginning, like Genesis and the book of John?
2. Notice John writes "If we say" 3 times (verses 6, 8, 10). What are the three points John is trying to make?
3. How has God dealt with the sin of those who believe in him (1 John 2:1-2)?
4. How does God want you to deal with your sin (1 John 1:8-10)?
