# At Home Study Guide

For the week of July 29, 2018

*Psalm 51:1-19*

*During June and July we will consider the life of David. He was a man who lived his life on mission: loving God, loving others, and serving the world. Consider how he points us to Jesus, through whom we can live out the same mission.*

This is one of the few Psalms that tell us the specific reason the author wrote the Psalm. If needed, review 2 Samuel 11 and 12.

David sinned against other people. Why is David speaking directly to God in Psalm 51?

What attributes of God does David appeal to? What does he ask God to do in him?

What has sin done in you, and how is this Psalm helpful to you as you seek restoration from your sins?
