What is the mystery, according to verse 6? How is this good news for you and me?

When was this plan made (verses 9-11)? In what ways is this plan, by God's grace, an encouragement to you?

Paul prays for the Ephesians (and for us) in verses 14-21. What are the three major items he prays for the Ephesians? Talk about what Paul's conclusion in verses 20-21 means to you.
