Ephesians 5:1-21

As we study the book of Ephesians, remember that Paul was writing to them to challenge them to think of themselves as people in Christ – people who had been given a new identity. In the same way, as you study this book, consider what Paul is teaching you about your identity in Christ.

1. Paul begins this chapter with a connection back to 4:17 – don't imitate the Gentiles, but imitate God! How are we to imitate God, according to verse 2?

2. Paul continues the theme of walking in verses 8 and 15. How does that theme help you understand how to live the Christian life (see 1 John 1:5-7)?

3. Another major theme is to be filled with (controlled by) the Holy Spirit. How does the Spirit control and guide positively, in contrast to wine controlling us negatively?
