Quick Review

Jesus’ audience understood farming so he took an opportunity to express a paradox through the story of a seed. The terms Jesus used were easy to understand. They knew that a harvest was the result of dying seeds giving way to new life. Jesus’ life must be given up so that new life can be realized by those who would believe and follow Him. For the follower of Jesus, seeking honor from the Father would require humble self-giving service. Emptying oneself in service to Jesus is the only path to righteousness. This paradox of living in a way that is seemingly dishonorable (dying to self) is the path to greater honor (from God Himself).

How is the REAL acronym proving helpful to you in following Jesus?

According to John 12:26, what is the greatest honor one can receive in following Jesus?

In Deuteronomy 6:4 and Luke 10:27, what is the big idea for those who want to be honored in the Kingdom of God?

As you have time, consider these examples of sharp contrast as a reminder of the priority of love for God over love for the world: Gen 29:30-31; Mal 1:2; Rom 9:12; Matt 5:43.

How does Jesus’ teaching in Mark 10:42-45 correlate with this passage in John?

Consider the To Go’s from the message on Sunday. Is there one that stands out? Encourage one another in your application of becoming empty that Jesus may receive greater honor in your life.
