To Go

Quick Review

This summer we are considering stories from the Old Testament and their abiding relevance today. As you study the passage, look beyond your notes to glean more truth from this passage by using these questions, so that you can find a greater harvest of truth!

Context: Gen. 22 opens with the words “After these things.” What things? Who was Isaac and why was he important?

Observation: Who are the main characters in Gen. 22? Why does God test Abraham? What is the conflict or high point in the passage? What do you think Abraham was expecting might happen (see Heb. 11:17-19)?

Meaning: How does passage point forward to the person and work of Christ? How could you sum up the meaning of this passage in your own words?

Application: How does this passage challenge your understanding about who God is and what he is like? Is there some attitude or belief you need to change?
