At Home Study Guide

For the week of August 20

Daniel 6

This summer we are considering stories from the Old Testament and their abiding relevance today. As you study the passage, look beyond your notes to glean more truth from this passage by using these questions, so that you can find a greater harvest of truth!

Context: Notice the similarities and differences between Daniel 3 and 6. How is each challenged to worship or perish in a pit?

Observation: Observe the many ways that the word “deliver” is used in this passage. Also note the irony of weakness which is strength, and strength which is actually weakness.

Meaning: How does God make their law ineffective and deliver judgment upon those who are seeking to judge?

Application: There is one who has gone into the pit and lived in order to deliver all those who are threatened with the pit themselves. In what situation do you need to trust God to deliver? How do you need to remain faithful in opposition?
